Prince William area residents who should call:

- Those who have an eviction notice.
- Those who are behind on their rent.
- Those who have been asked to leave a relative/friend's house and have nowhere else to go.
- Those currently living in the woods or their car.
- Those who are assisting others to prevent homelessness.

How It Works

- Our goal is to prevent eviction or assist Prince William area residents in accessing safe temporary or permanent housing.
- We listen to residents as they share their current living situation.
- We ask that residents work with us to answer some quick housing questions.
- We support residents in accessing rental assistance to keep their current housing or find a safe place to sleep.
- We will continue to work with residents as their situation changes.
